This guarantee will cover the amount of duties based on the inventory, considering 50% of the declared value.</p> <p><b>It is required that a copy of the packing list of each HHGD shipment arriving at ports/airports in Brazil, must be attached together with the usual documentation required for Customs clearance.</b> <b>If not provided, fine will be charged.</b></p> <p>Duty free entry for personal goods and new items of personal/owner use as long as these are not for commercial purposes. These need to be declared as NEW in the packing list and detailed with mark/serial number/model in case of electric/electronic appliances.</p> <p>This does not apply to consumer items such as foodstuff, diapers, cosmetics, candles, paint, etc.</p>	<p>For Permanent/Temporary visa. Goods must not arrive in Brazil later than 180 days after owner's arrival.</p> <p>Shipment must originate from the same country of the owners nationality or where he was living at time of shipment.</p> <p><b>For Brazilian returning a certificate of residence abroad for minimum 1 year must be obtained at the Brazilian Consulate at origin in order to avoid taxes.</b></p>

Arms, Ammunition, dangerous objects	See removal goods.	Subject to consultation with the Brazilian Army prior to departure from country of origin.	Small calibre only, for personal use, hunting rifles. No dangerous objects allowed. Guns and ammunitions will be retained until inspected by the army officials.
Medicines, narcotics, drugs		Small quantities of non-prescription medicines or prescription medicines with doctor's prescription may be imported. Narcotics and drugs are not allowed.	
Wood			<p>A fumigation certificate must be issued at origin for raw material "IN NATURA" for all countries except U.S.A, China, Hong Kong, South Korea, North Korea and Japan for which countries the importation is forbidden.</p> <p>The above-mentioned prescription is no longer needed as all shipments coming into this country will be inspected by the Agricultural department and if needed, fumigation will be performed at destination.</p>
